## WHAT IS THE AMOUNT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP?

The scholarship recipient(s) will receive \$2,000 to be used at any college, university or post graduate vocational school.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The student applicant must be a legal dependent of an active CCASAPE member and currently enrolled as a senior in a Clark County School District secondary school.

## WHAT ARE THE TIMELINES?

1. The scholarship packet must be received in the CCASAPE office on or before **Monday, April 16, 2012**. Send packet to:

2. Selection of the recipients will be made by the CCASAPE Scholarship Committee in early May.

## WHAT MUST BE INCLUDED IN THE APPLICATION PACKET?

1. **THE APPROPRIATE COVER PAGE** – Use the attached form provided in the application information sent to each school.
2. **TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION** – One of the two letters should be from a counselor and the other from a teacher.
3. **A TRANSCRIPT** of the high school grades including the first semester of the senior year. The ACT / SAT scores must be included with the transcript.
4. **A RESUME** – Applicants must demonstrate participation/leadership in extracurricular activities and community service.
5. **AN ESSAY** – No longer than two typewritten pages which is based on one of the following:
  - a. Recount an educational experience that has made or left a significant impression on you and discuss how it has influenced your life.
  - b. Complete and discuss this phrase:

**THE STUDENT APPLICATION WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FOLLOWING ELEMENTS:**

1. The cumulative grade point average (weighted grades are taken into account - seven semesters are worth a maximum of 20 points per the following breakdown):

4.80 – 3.80 = 20 points

3.79 – 3.30 = 16 points

3.29 – 2.50 = 12 points

2. Tests scores on the ACT/SAT are worth a maximum of 10 points per the following breakdown:

| <b>ACT</b>          | <b>or</b> | <b>SAT</b>              |
|---------------------|-----------|-------------------------|
| 28 – 36 = 10 points |           | 1850 - 2400 = 10 points |
| 24 – 27 = 8 points  |           | 1640 - 1849 = 8 points  |
| 20 – 23 = 6 points  |           | 1410 - 1639 = 6 points  |

(If both tests taken, the higher score will be used.)

3. The student resume is worth 20 points. Participation in school activities, leadership and community service should be evident.
4. The essay to be judged by the CCASAPE Scholarship Committee is worth 30 points.
5. The letters of recommendation are worth 20 points.
